

## Operating Regulations – JEŠTĚD Bikepark

**TMR Ještěd a.s., IČ: 06080413, with its registered office at Jablonecká 41/27, 460 05 Liberec,** is the operator of the Bikepark at the Ještěd Ski Resort. This operating regulation governs the operation of cycling trails and sets the obligations for both the operator and users in order to achieve maximum safety during operation.

JEŠTĚD Bikepark consists of two trails of varying difficulty levels:

- B1 - "La Spaghetta"
  - Freeride trail combining dirt and wooden obstacles
  - Difficulty: Moderate
- B3 - "El Masacre Downhill"
  - Downhill technical trail suitable for bikes with long travel suspension
  - Difficulty: Hard

1. The Bike park may only be used by visitors of the Ještěd Ski Resort who have purchased the relevant ticket for the Skalka cable car, and only during the resort's operating hours (9:05 AM – 5:05 PM). The transportation of bicycles is free of charge.

2. By purchasing a valid non-transferable ticket at the self-service kiosk at the resort's Infocenter or online through the Gopass program, which also serves as an entry ticket to the bike park, the user agrees to comply with these operating regulations and rides at their own risk. In the event of a violation of the operating rules, the user will be excluded from further operations, and their ticket will be confiscated without compensation and blocked. A photo will be taken when passing through the turnstile, which will be processed and stored by the ticketing system. This personal photo (image) will be retained for the validity period of the ticket and then deleted. Tickets are non-transferable. By purchasing the ticket, the user agrees to the general terms and conditions.

3. The travel document is issued by the carrier – TMR Ještěd a.s. – in the form of a contactless chip card – KEY CARD – with or without the holder's identification details, depending on the type of ticket as specified in the valid price list. The contactless chip card – KEY CARD – entitles the holder to use the services provided at the Ještěd Ski Resort operated by TMR Ještěd a.s. according to the type of purchased ticket as specified in the valid price list of the carrier.

The travel document may also be a Gopass chip card with a purchased product within the Gopass loyalty program, which is based on the principle of purchasing goods and services through the program's online store and can use goX Cashback (according to the applicable Gopass Program Terms and Conditions). Membership in the Gopass loyalty program is conditional upon registration at [www.gopass.travel](http://www.gopass.travel). All membership rules are governed by the General Terms and Conditions of the Gopass program, issued by Tatra Mountain Resorts, a.s. in accordance with the legal regulations of the Slovak Republic, available on [www.gopass.travel](http://www.gopass.travel).

4. Only mountain bikes are permitted in the bike park. Users must be equipped with a protective helmet. We recommend wearing a back protector, knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards.

5. Every user is required to act considerately so as not to cause injury or any other damage to themselves, the operator, or third parties and is fully responsible for any damage caused by their actions in the bike park. They must adjust their riding speed and choice of trail according to their abilities, the condition of the bike park's tracks, and the weather conditions. The use of trails, obstacles, and other movement in the bike park is at the rider's own risk. When riding through forested areas, users are required to comply with the provisions and restrictions of the forestry law. Riders must respect local markings (pictograms) and the instructions of the bike park or cable car staff. The operator is not responsible for any injuries or damages caused.

6. It is prohibited to leave the designated trails and move freely on neighboring land.

7. When crossing local service roads or riding on them, applicable legal regulations, particularly the Road Traffic Act and the Road Traffic Regulations Act, apply – users of the bike park must comply with the relevant traffic rules and road signs.

8. If any defects are detected on the trail, obstacles, signage, or other issues within the bike park, users are required to promptly report this to the bike park operator. If an injury to another person is detected, the user must provide first aid and report the incident to the operator (Information Center, cable car control center, mountain rescue). An accident report will be made with the bike park operator or the mountain rescue team.

9. Users of the bike park are required to keep the obstacles and the bike park area clean.

10. Every rider must carry their ticket with them at all times. It must be presented upon request by the designated operator staff, in the case of an emergency, etc. The ticket is non-transferable to other persons.

11. Access to the park is prohibited for persons who are intoxicated or under the influence of other addictive substances. Smoking is prohibited in the park and during the ride on the cable car.

12. Children under 12 years old are only allowed on the bike park trails when accompanied by a parent, coach from a sports club, or another similarly responsible adult. This person is fully responsible for the child and must supervise them throughout their time in the bike park.

13. The operator reserves the right to close part or all of the bike park in the following cases:

- When organizing competitions and training sessions
- In case of adverse weather conditions (strong winds, thunderstorms) when the cable car is out of operation
- In case of emergency situations that endanger the safety of the operation
- During park maintenance and repairs

14. Outside operating hours, the bike park is closed, and it is prohibited to enter the trails.
